It is mi-cuit foie gras in a vacuum-packed roulade that has a shelf life of six weeks from the date of manufacture. This means that it is very fresh, much better than anything tinned, and can be frozen. I import it from a small family-run farm in Perigord where they have been making foie gras since 1920, and have won the prestigious Prix d'Or for many of their produce. One 460g roulade will feed 12 people and makes a wonderful present.
